DIRECTIONS & PARKING

From Interstate 81 take Exit 74B for US-11 S towards Kingsport. Merge onto E. Stone Dr/TN-1//US-11W. Continue to follow E. Stone Dr/TN-1/US-11W for 15.3 miles. Turn left at N. Eastman Rd.; 1205 N. Eastman Rd. is 1.4 miles on the left.

Since 1943, the Kingsport Area Chamber of Commerce, CSX Transportation (and its predecessors) and Food City have co-sponsored the Santa Train. The annual 110-mile rail "Christmas Parade" from Shelby, Kentucky to Kingsport, Tennessee, is an Appalachian tradition that ushers in the holiday season in the region.
